

ATTENTION!

Visitors of the Registry of Seamen are asked to **be responsible** and **obey the epidemiological rules** introduced by the government of Latvia in order to prevent the spread of the Covid-19.

In compliance with the Cabinet Order No. 360 “Epidemiological safety measures for the prevention of the spread of the Covid-19 disease”¹, adopted 9 June 2020, **the on-site services of the Registry of Seamen are denied to the persons, who:**

- **are subject to self-isolation** (returned, during past 10 days, from the countries listed on the website² of the Centre for Disease Prevention and Control Republic of Latvia (CDPC) and to which the special precautionary and preventive measures apply);
- **are subject to home quarantine or isolation** (the person recognised by the CDPC as a contact person of the Covid-19 infection, or diagnosed with Covid-19);
- **has symptoms of respiratory infection.**

If the requirements of the epidemiological safety are violated, administrative liability may be imposed.

In the event of the further spread of the Covid-19, the information about the recipient of the services of the Registry of Seamen may be given to the CDPC.

By receiving the services of the Registry of Seamen, the person certifies that he/she has been familiarized and agrees with the above terms.
